ORDER LIFTING BAN ON OUTDOOR BURNING

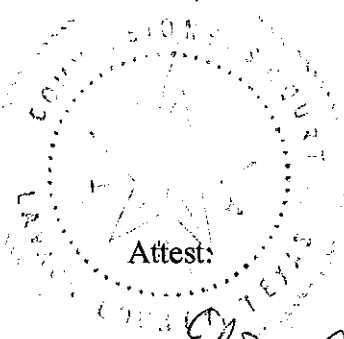
WHEREAS, During the regular session of the Lavaca County Commissioners Court on June 11, 2018, the Court implemented a Burn Ban unanimously.

WHEREAS, In the Order issued that date, the Court authorized the County Judge the authority to release the ban when conditions allow.


WHEREAS, precipitation has fallen throughout Lavaca County over the past 24 hours, and


WHEREAS, with the authority issued by the Commissioners Court of Lavaca County,
NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED, ON THIS THE 20th DAY OF JUNE, 2018, I HEREBY LIFT THE COUNTY-WIDE BURN BAN.

I continue to caution all citizens of Lavaca County to exercise great caution with outdoor burning and to assume responsibility to contact your local fire chief and have safeguards in place before attempting any burning. Any citizen who chooses to conduct a burn is liable for any and all damages caused as a result of that burn.
