- Must have computer and internet access for course

Victoria College EMS Program

The program is a selective-admissions program that offers one-semester EMT courses for certification/employment and/ or students can continue through the Paramedic Program from May-April (3 semesters) toward certification as a paramedic. Paramedic class days are shift-based allowing EMTs to work while taking classes. VC EMS also offers an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree in EMS.

Accepted Applicants

Accepted applicants will be registered for EMSP 1501 (EMT Course) and EMSP 1160 (EMT Clinic) for 6 credit hours. Upon successful completion of the course, graduates are eligible to seek certification from the National Registry of EMTs (NREMT) and subsequent certification with Texas Department of State Health Services for employment.
