10. Discuss and/or approve the 2026–2027 Texas Association of Counties (TAC) Health and Employee Benefits Renewal Notice.

The proposed 2026–2027 employee benefits renewal includes the following changes: Participation in the Blue Choice Network Health Plan 1300-NG, featuring:

- a. Individual deductible: \$1,500
- b. Family deductible: \$4,500
- c. In-network coinsurance: 80/20, with maximum out-of-pocket coinsurance of \$3,500
- d. Out-of-network coinsurance: 60/40, with a maximum out-of-pocket coinsurance of \$7,000

- Addition of a 15% Dependent Pilot Program designed to reduce the cost of dependent coverage for employees.
- Addition of a Medical Flexible Spending Account (FSA) option to assist employees with managing eligible medical expenses for themselves, their spouses, and dependents.
- Dental coverage will remain unchanged; however, premiums will increase by 9.8% over the previous year's rates.
- Vision coverage will remain unchanged with no premium increase.
- Basic Life Insurance coverage is proposed to increase from \$10,000 to \$15,000 or \$25,000 per employee.


