WHEREAS, During the regular called meeting of the Lavaca County Commissioner's Court on August 25, 2025, the Court ratified the Burn Ban Order unanimously.

WHEREAS, In the Order issued that date, the Court authorized the County Judge the authority to release the ban when conditions allow.

WHEREAS, County Judge Keith Mudd signed an Executive Order lifting the county wide Burn Ban on December 5, 2025, and


WHEREAS, with the authority issued by the Commissioners Court of Lavaca County,

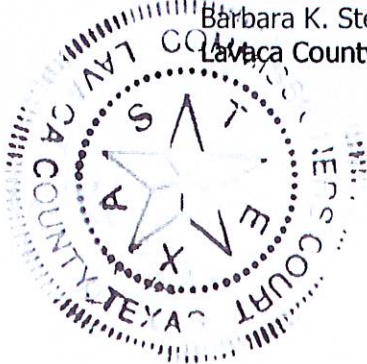

Any citizen who chooses to conduct a burn is liable for any and all damages caused as a result of that burn.
