SERVICEMEMBER'S CIVIL RELIEF ACT AFFIDAVIT

The requirement for an affidavit may be satisfied by a written, signed document declared to be true under penalty of perjury. If it appears that the defendant is in military service, the court may not enter a judgment until after the court appoints an attorney to represent the defendant. If the court is unable to determine if the defendant is in military service, the court may require the plaintiff to file a bond in an amount approved by the court. To obtain certificates of service or non-service under the Civil Relief Act, you access the public website: Servicemember's may https://www.dmdc.osd.mil/applj/scra/scraHome.do. This website will provide the current active military status of an individual.
