
Lavaca County LEPC Meeting

Thursday, August 25, 2022

Enterprise Products Partners L.P.

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 10:04 AM by Mark Hercheck. Attendance sheet attached.
- 2. Information was provided on the purpose of a LEPC, when Lavaca LEPC will meet, and membership. The handout is attached.
 - a) TDEM form 151 was passed to each person in attendance to sign up as a member. Egon Barthels will enter the data into the state system.
 - b) Elections were held for the positions of Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary. Theresa Bowe nominated Mark Hercheck for Chair, Egon Barthels as Vice Chair, and Lorren Cason as Secretary. Nicholas Kresta seconded the motion. The motion carried.
 - c) The group discussed reaching out to other organizations that need to attend the LEPC meetings. Suggestions were made to invite funeral home directors, Kinder Morgan, Midway, TXDOT, Oilfield sites, Boedecker Plastics, Farm Pac, and Bludua Fabrications. Egon will reach out to these groups as well as anyone who has sent in Tier II data to his office.
 - d) Egon and Mark informed the group that entities required to report TIER II data to them have been turning in reports. Egon reported the information can be reported to his office electronically on the Lavaca Emergency Management page.
 - e) Hazardous materials training is available through TDEM. Any entity needing specific training can reach out to Egon for assistance facilitating specific trainings. Yoakum Fire Department expressed interest an anhydrous ammonia training.
 - f) Ernie Paiz spoke with group about Commodity Flow Studies. The Federal government has a program that pays a team to come into our community and write down every hazardous material traveling through our county. The study can be used by the LEPC and County to help create an emergency plan in response to these hazards. City and County officials can also use the information to work with TXDOT on specific routes the trucks transporting hazardous material must use.
- 3. A brief conversation was had about the sub-committees of the LEPC. The committees consist of Right-to-know, Public Education, Hazardous Materials Facilities Liaison, Emergency Response and Resources, and Finance. Lorren Cason will bring more information on each committee to the next meeting.
- 4. A presentation on the Enterprise Plant was given by Darryll Langhoff, Darrell Slatter, and Jeff Lackey. The group was informed the plant participates in drills with the local fire departments and EMS to prepare for any event.
- 5. Mark Hercheck will send out an invite via email once the date for the next meeting has been set. The meeting was adjourned at 11:01 AM by Mark Hercheck.
