The Lavaca County Commissioners' Court met in a Regular Called Meeting on Monday, March 23, 2015 at 10:00 A. M. in the Lavaca County Commissioners' Courtroom, 1st Floor, in Hallettsville, Texas with Judge Tramer J. Woytek presiding and with Commissioner Edward Pustka, Pct. 1, Commissioner Ronald Berckenhoff, Pct. 2, Commissioner R. W. Brown, Pct. 3, and Commissioner Dennis W. Kocian, Pct. 4 all being present. The meeting was called to order by Judge Tramer J. Woytek followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the U.S. and Texas Flags.

Under Public Communications, Commissioner Edward Pustka stated that the Lavaca River Bridge at Vienna was supposed to be completed about the middle of April. Due to the river coming up a couple of times, they lost some of their supplies. They did get most of the supplies back, however it backed the completion date back about a month. The bridge should be in complete operation by mid June if there are no other setbacks.

Commissioner R. W. Brown said that County Road 392 at the low water crossing closest to Yoakum was rebuilt two weeks ago with two large pipes. It should have been cemented, however the gentleman that was supposed to cement it passed away and the job was not completed. The recent rain has washed it out, therefore closing the road. The pipes were destroyed and new ones ordered. The pipes are coming in Thursday and construction of the new culvert will begin Monday provided it does not rain.
