Egon Barthels, Lavaca County Emergency Management Coordinator, gave an update as follows:

- Animal Rights Activists were present in Hallettsville and received assistance from the Hallettsville Police Department along with Texas Department of Emergency Management
- A Cement Truck rollover was investigated and there was no fuel spill
- COVID-19 Update:
 - Mobile testing was held in Moulton at the St. Joseph Parish Social Center, Tuesday, June 16, 2020 with 115 tests administered.
 - Those who were tested at the mobile testing site will receive a text message with a link to a portal with results and information.
 - Those receiving a positive test will be contacted by the local health department.
 - As of this morning, June 22, 2020, there are 88 Confirmed cases in Lavaca County – 20 Recovered and 68 Active.
 - The Department of State Health Services reports that they can no longer support a 24 hr. turnaround of results after testing.
