ORDER LIFTING BAN ON OUTDOOR BURNING

WHEREAS, During the regular called meeting of the Lavaca County Commissioner's Court on October 23, 2023, the Court implemented a Burn Ban unanimously.

WHEREAS, In the Order issued that date, the Court authorized the County Judge the authority to release the ban when conditions allow.

WHEREAS, significant precipitation has fallen throughout Lavaca County over the past 10 days, and the KBDI average has fallen well below 500.

WHEREAS, with the authority issued by the Commissioners Court of Lavaca County,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED ON THIS 1ST DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2023, I HEREBY LIFT THE COUNTY-WIDE BURN BAN.

Please continue to use caution with any outdoor burning and have safeguards in place before you burn. Any citizen who chooses to conduct a burn is liable for any and all damages caused as a result of that burn.

Note: The Lavaca County Dispatchers Office requests that you call 361-798-2121 before you burn brush piles or pastures. Calling before you burn prevents our volunteer fire departments from being unnecessarily dispatched to a controlled burn. Please call before you burn.


