ORDER LIFTING RESTRICTIONS ON OUTDOOR BURNING

WHEREAS, the Lavaca County Commissioners Court ordered, at its November 23, 2020 meeting, that restrictions on outdoor burning in the unincorporated areas of Lavaca County, Texas, which are designated to become effective on November 23, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, at the November 23, 2020 meeting, the Lavaca County Commissioners Court designated that the Lavaca County Judge have the authority to terminate this Order in accordance with Local Government Code Section 352.081 (c) (2); and,

WHEREAS, the Lavaca County Judge has considered the recent rains and determined that the circumstances present on November 30, 2020, in the unincorporated areas of Lavaca County that created a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning, no longer exist.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Lavaca County Judge that the previous order of November 23, 2020, which banned outdoor burning, is lifted and the restrictions set forth are removed until such time as the Lavaca County Commissioners Court may take further action regarding the same.
