## ORDER AUTHORIZING MEMORIAL DAY FIREWORKS SALE

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Lavaca County is authorized under Occupations Code Section 2154.202(h), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public in celebration of Memorial Day; and

WHEREAS, on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2023, the Commissioners Court of Lavaca County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue an Order;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Lavaca County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the Memorial Day period beginning May 24, 2023 and ending at midnight May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023, subject to the following restrictions:

- a) This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023, whichever is earlier.
- b) Lavaca County Commissioners Court issues a Burn Ban.


