## **IMPORTANT BALLOT BY MAIL APPLICATION DEADLINE FOR THE NOVEMBER 5<sup>TH</sup> GENERAL ELECTION**

**Hallettsville, Texas** — Registered voters in Lavaca County who plan on voting by mail must have a **2024 Ballot by Mail Application** on file with the Lavaca County Elections Department. Lavaca County will only mail out a ballot by mail application IF it is requested by the voter. A few organizations and parties are sending out Ballot by Mail Applications, too. Therefore, it is not uncommon for a Lavaca County voter to get 2 or more applications for ballot by mail via US Postal Service. Your county elections office only needs one 2024 Application for Ballot by Mail on file. The **deadline for turning in Applications for Ballot by Mail is Friday, October 25th**.
