### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MOULTON, TEXAS, TO ADOPT THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

**WHEREAS**, emergency response to critical incidents, whether natural or man made, requires integrated professional management; and

**WHEREAS**, unified command of such incidents is recognized as the management model to maximize the public safety response; and

**WHEREAS**, the National Incident Management System (NIMS) has been identified by the federal government as being the requisite emergency management system for all political subdivisions; and

**WHEREAS**, failure to adopt NIMS as the requisite emergency management system may preclude reimbursement to the political subdivision for costs expended during and after a declared emergency or disaster and for training and preparation for such disasters or emergencies;

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOULTON, TEXAS:

- Section 1.** That the City of Moulton, Texas adopts the NIMS concept of emergency planning and incident command.
- Section 2.** In furtherance of NIMS, it is the policy of the City of Moulton to train public officials and employees responsible for emergency management.
- Section 3.** Directs that incident managers and response organizations in our jurisdiction train and exercise the Incident Command System (ICS) and use it in their response operations.
